

LizardTech Celebrating 20th Anniversary

LizardTech, USA, celebrates its 20th anniversary this year. As part of the celebrations, and to reflect on how it all started with the introduction of MrSID two decades ago, the company is holding a contest asking participants to say how MrSID has come to their rescue.

Since then, the company has continued to improve the MrSID image format with support for lossless compression in MrSID Generation 3 and now support for multi- and hyperspectral imagery and alpha bands in MrSID Generation 4.

Since the arrival of the file format, LizardTech has introduced other tools to help geospatial professionals in their everyday workflow. LizardTech's geospatial line of products include [GeoExpress](#) software, which enables geospatial professionals to compress and manipulate satellite and aerial imagery, [Express Server](#) software for high-performance delivery and publication, and [Lidar Compressor](#) software, which turns giant point cloud datasets into efficient MrSID files.
