URISA has announced that it welcomes applications for the 2013 Vanguard Cabinet. Submissions from interested young professionals are due on or before 7 December 2012. The Vanguard Cabinet is a URISA initiative to engage young GIS practitioners, increase their numbers in the organisation, and better understand the concerns facing these future leaders of the GIS community.

URISA's Vanguard Cabinet (VC) was introduced in 2011 and is an advisory board made up of URISA young professionals who represent the young membership of the organisation. The Cabinet's mission is to collaborate with URISA's Board of Directors and Committees in creating and promoting programs and policies of benefit to young professionals. Comprised entirely of passionate young members selected from different geospatial disciplines, the Cabinet aims to position URISA as the center of opportunities for creative young professionals who are committed to improving URISA and the geospatial profession via innovation, collaboration, networking, and professional development.

Clare Brown leads the Steering Committee which supports the Vanguard Cabinet.
