

ASPRS Hot Topics Sessions at ILMF 2014



The International LiDAR Mapping Forum (ILMF), taking place from 17-19 February 2014, in Denver, CO, USA, has announced that the American Society for Photogrammetry and Remote Sensing (ASPRS) will be running special “Hot Topics”™ sessions alongside the main conference.

ASPRS plays a vital role in the Lidar industry as it is the key organisation that sets data format and accuracy standards for kinematic laser scanning. With a full morning dedicated to ASPRS on Monday, 17 February, ASPRS will provide an update on activities of the society associated with Lidar and point cloud processing including:

- The new concept of LAS Domain Profiles
- The newly created bathymetric profile for littoral mapping
- Accuracy metrics being jointly developed by the ASPRS and the USGS for Lidar calibration and project geometric correction
- Best practices specifications for mobile laser scanning
