

Collaboration on Dutch BGT Project

Orbit GeoSpatial Technologies, Belgium, and NedGraphics, The Netherlands, have announced their intention to collaborate on the national 'Basisregistratie Grootschalige Topografie' (BGT, Key Register Large-scale Topography) project. The companies have signed a cooperation agreement to integrate Orbit GT's software solutions for mapping into NedGraphics' portfolio for government GIS solutions. BGT is the name of the Dutch project to create a country-wide detailed base map, holding local governments responsible for their relevant part of the country.
