

Geo Week/ILMF Postponed Due to Coronavirus Concerns



Diversified Communications has made the "very difficult decision" to postpone the upcoming edition of Geo Week, which was planned to take place at the Walter E. Washington Convention Center in Washington DC, USA, from 23-25 March. This is due to the magnitude of the unanticipated public health and safety issues posed by the rapidly escalating COVID-19 outbreaks and contagion.
