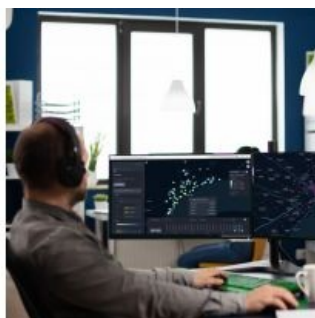


# GIS People introduces educational e-book: open-source GIS vs commercial GIS
