

# Maptek Opens New Office in Calgary

Maptek has opened a new office in Calgary, Alberta, Canada. The office will be managed by Carlito deSouza, who has experience in the oil and gas industry as well as having held various technical services roles in the drilling and exploration sectors.

As I-Site Technical Services consultant, Carlito will initially concentrate on expanding the I-Site sales and consulting business in the region. The new Maptek office is located in the southeast part of Calgary, in a commercial area outside the city core.
