Power Program

The Power Program offers the MicroStation PowerDraft CADD product and an upgrade path to more comprehensive solutions for distributed enterprises–through a subscription-based model.

Infrastructure software is complex and mission-critical â€^e relationships between users and vendors are critical, with regular contact a requirement for success. Unfortunately, the common situation in China is that these relationships are broken and the benefits are not making it to users.

The Power Program's subscription-based model establishes those relationships and immediately raises the benefits of software for the China infrastructure community. And, in appreciation for the first-year start-up and training costs that many new users may incur, the program offers a year of free subscriptions to new users.

The PowerDraft Private option offers users and developers in China a first-year subscription to MicroStation PowerDraft for free; the price for future years is 200 RMB per year. The software is supplied as a full product (not a demo) in the Chinese language.
