Version 4.0 features new support for Oracle database connectivity specifically for Spatial Data Object (SDO) geometry types. Also new is GeoConvert, which allows for map-file translation between formats like MIF, TAB, DWG, DXF and SHP. Another new feature is support for Well-Known Text (WKT) coordinate reference system definition. Users can define their own object types and datum shifts.
