



viaEuropa Includes South Sudan

Geo-data service provider Europa Technologies is launching an update to its family of global data products. The 2011.2 release reflects recent changes to political borders, making the company the first data provider to publish a digital map showing the newly formed nation of South Sudan.

The update also covers first level administrative boundaries worldwide, more countries with second level administrative boundaries, plus Middle Eastern road networks, including city streets at 1:50,000 scale.

Europa Technologies is highlighting the release at the Esri International User Conference, taking place in San Diego, California, this week.

viaEuropa provides access to high quality, pre-rendered global map tiles which support the delivery of digital maps direct to web, desktop and mobile applications.

All existing business and government customers on Europa Technologies' subscription service will automatically receive updates to their products from mid-July based on the 2011.2 release.
